



Adult First Time License Checklist

The Road to Your License...the Final Mile!

You have two options on how to use your Adult Driver Ed Completion Certificate: You can use it either to get a learner's license if you need to practice driving OR to go ahead and take the driving test if you are ready for your driver license test.

All new license applicants aged 18-24 are required to:

- Complete 6 hour Adult Driver Education course with SafeWay Driving!**
- Receive your ADEE-1317 Adult Driver Education Certificate after course completion, which is emailed by SafeWay.**
- Complete the free one hour Impact Texas Adult Drivers at <https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/ITAD/>**
- Schedule your Road Skills Test. The Road Skills Test is conveniently offered at your local SafeWay Drive Site* or you can schedule at your nearest DPS office (at <https://www.dps.texas.gov/>) and wait in line.**

You will need the following items when you go to the DPS:

- DL-14A Form - Application for Texas Driver License (available at DPS)
- ADEE-1317 Adult Driver Education Certificate provided by SafeWay Driving
- Proof of identity and lawful US presence or citizenship: valid passport OR your official birth certificate, social security card, and Texas ID card
- Original Birth Certificate and one copy
For Non Citizens - visit <https://www.dps.texas.gov/section/driver-license/us-citizenship-or-lawful-presence-requirement>
- Original Social Security Card and one copy
For Non Citizens - Social Security Affidavit form available at DPS
- Texas Residency Affidavit DL-5 form with two acceptable forms of proof of Texas residency (both in your name)
- IMPACT Texas Adult Drivers Course Certificate (School Code C3442)
- Proof of Texas Vehicle Registration and financial responsibility for the vehicle (ex: car insurance). *****Only applicable if you are testing with the DPS.**
- Glasses or contacts (if needed)
- \$33.00 New Driver License Fee (subject to change)
