The Road to Your License

-
- Complete your 3rd online session and pass both the Road Rules and Road Signs Test.
 - Visit <https://www.dps.texas.gov/> for DPS locations and hours.
 - Bring these **REQUIRED ITEMS** with you when you go to the DPS:
 - Your Original Birth Certificate
 - Your Original Social Security Card
 - EITHER your Student ID or recent Official Report Card
 - VOE (Verification of Enrollment) Form from your High School
 - Two Acceptable Forms of Texas Residency w/Texas Residency Affidavit Form
 - Documents supporting Texas Residency must be in the name of the **parent** who shares your address and is taking you to the DPS
 - DEE-964 Pink Permit Certificate emailed by SafeWay Driving
 - DL14b Application for License provided by the DPS office
 - \$16.00 Learner's Permit Fee (subject to change)
 - Glasses or Contacts (if needed)
 - Parent or Legal Guardian
